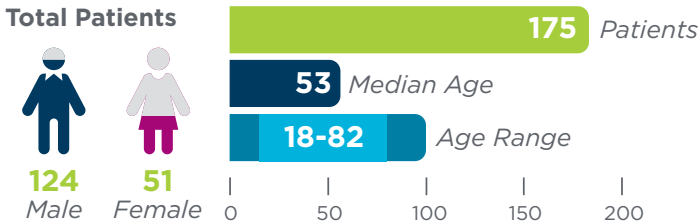

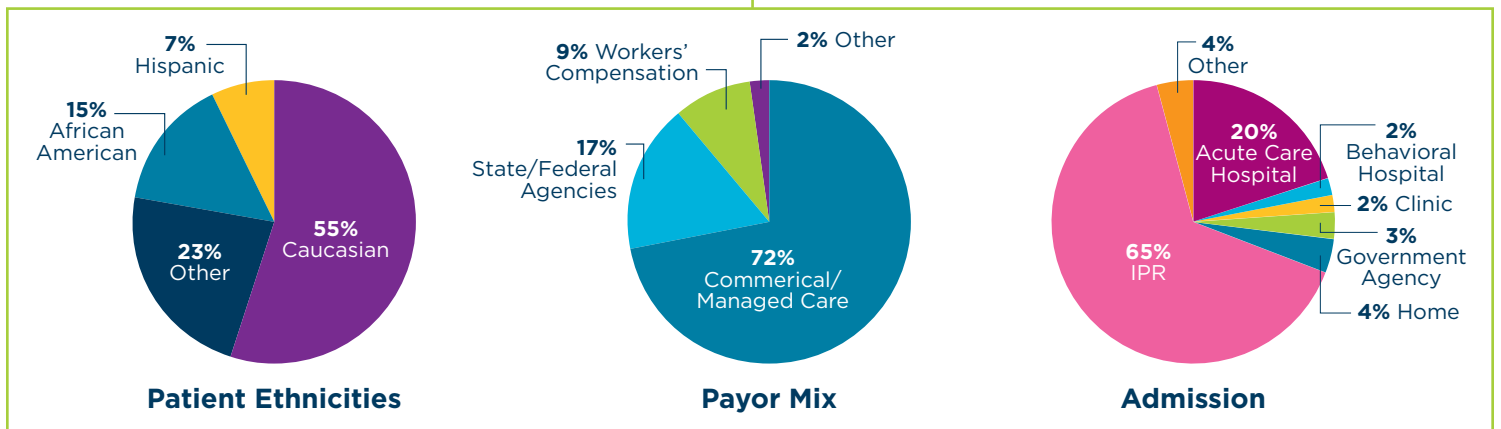
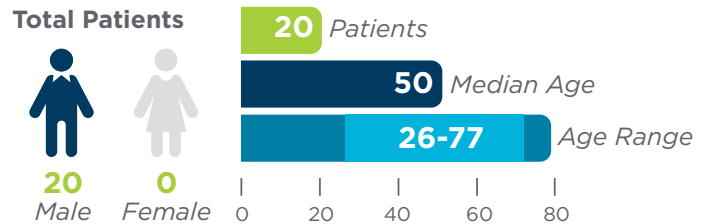
## Transitional Rehabilitation Services

Residents are individuals with a length of stay more than one year.

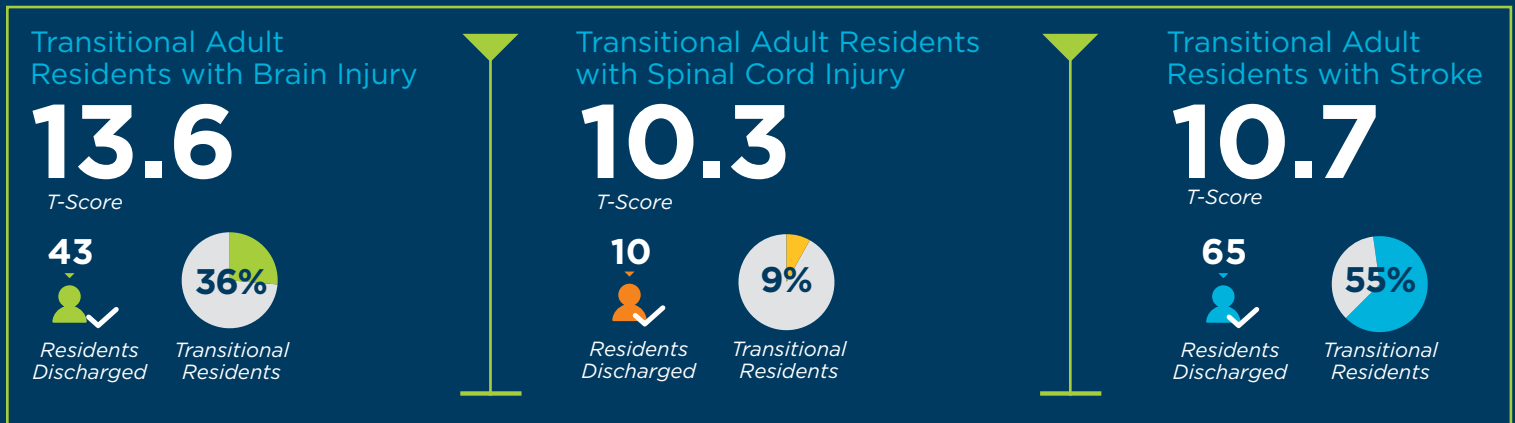


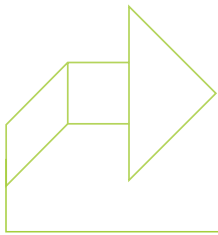
## Transitional Residential Care

The progress individuals achieve while participating in our therapeutic programs is measured using the Mayo-Portland Adaptability Inventory-4 (MPAI-4), a nationally recognized tool utilized to assist with clinical evaluations. It represents a measure of physical, cognitive, emotional, behavioral, and social functioning that may be problematic. The data below uses the t-score observed from the MPAI-4, we understand if there is a statistically significant difference in improvement, or if any observed difference is just due to random chance. Generally, a t-score of 5 or greater indicates a **significant** difference between admission and discharge. A t-score of 9 or greater indicates a **robust** difference.

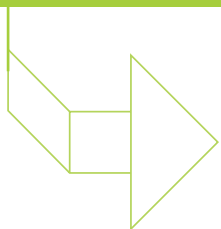
